Eco Wash Project at Roorkee

Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan is a national campaign. JBF team at Roorkee formed the committee for sustainability of this project. As per the committee following observations were made:

- Condition of washroom door was bad.
- Toilet sheets was not in proper condition.
- No water facility inside the toilet.
- Wash basin, mirror & hanger was not available.
- Only one soak pit was available

Under the project following renovation was made:

- Washroom door in proper condition.
- All toilet sheets has changed.
- Now water facility is available inside the toilet. Complete water facility system has been used.



- Before starting the project, there were 6 toilets. As per discussion with school staff, One Room has been prepared like bathroom where mirror, hanger, wash basin & water facility is available.
- Hanger is available inside the toilet.
- Earlier only one soak pit was available. Now one new soak pit is available. At present there are 2 soak pit available at school premises.



Math E Maze

Swasthya Prahari Project at Roorkee:

Swasthy prahari are health guards who work under health initiatives of Jubilant and focus on following objective.

- Strengthen the Govt. Immunization schedule through increasing the number of beneficiaries.
- Provide basics information in various health issues.
- Increasing institutional delivery to reduce IMR & MMR.

Approach for Swasthy Prahari project is

- Meeting and discussion with community members and other related stakeholders.
- Provide training to Swasthy prahari along with community member.
- Data compilation for sustainability of project.

Outcome of Swasthy Prahari Project is

- Immunization coverage is high as compare to FY 13-14. 2.81.8% immunized in case of infant complete immunization (0-12 Months).
- 95.1% covered in case of TT.
- Institutional delivery increase as compare to home delivery.
- No MMR found in FY 14-15.





Blood Donation Camp

Every year our nation requires about **4 Crore units** of blood, out of which only a meager **40 Lakh units** of blood are available. The **gift of blood** is the **gift of life**. There is no substitute for human blood. Every two seconds someone needs blood. More than 38,000 blood donations are needed every day. A total of 30 million blood components are transfused each year .More than 1 million new people are diagnosed with cancer each year. Many of them will need blood, sometimes daily, during their chemotherapy treatment. A single car accident victim can require as many as 100 units of blood. In the view of above JBF at various locations organised blood donation camps as below:
